



## **How to Use DermaWheat Wheatgrass Recovery Cream and Spray for Molluscum**

The main benefit of the treatment apart from its efficacy is that it is very safe and side effects, such as a little allergic reddening of the skin, are rare. If this does occur, simply stop the treatment for a week then resume with a once daily application.

The aim is to rid the skin of the molluscum pox virus. The way this happens with wheatgrass is not known exactly but is believed to be due to stimulation of the skin's immunity which then assists the body to rid itself of the virus. This is quite a different approach to the traditional burning, squeezing, freezing and various other "treatment" modalities. Our products are also markedly cheaper than the immuno-suppressant drug imiquimod which is recommended by some doctors for molluscum.

Please don't expect to see improvement overnight. It will more than likely take four to six weeks to see a definitive change for the better. Sometimes the spray is more effective than the cream and vice versa. We have no explanation for this, as the concentration of wheatgrass in the spray is higher than in the cream.

The directions are simple. Apply a small amount of either product to the spots twice daily if possible. It is not necessary to cover the surrounding skin. However, for large affected areas, the spray is much easier to apply and is more economical than the cream.
